



# Automotive Service Technology

Gordon Cooper Technology Center offers full-time career pathways to high school juniors, seniors and adults. A student is eligible to receive college credit for most full-time career majors. High School students are eligible to receive math credit for various career majors. Courses are offered from 8:10 to 11:10 AM and 12:55 to 3:55 PM Monday through Friday. A student can choose to attend either the AM or PM session or both sessions. All students must be assessed before entering a career major.

The overall goal of the **Automotive Service Technology** program is to prepare individuals for direct placement in automotive service repair. Instruction is offered in these automotive service areas: brakes, electrical and electronic systems, engine performance, and suspension and steering. Students may also have the opportunity to do On the Job training while being paid by local companies.

**Admission Requirements:** Reading skills at the 10th grade level or above, math skills at the 9th grade level or above.

**Academic Credits:** 1 unit of Geometry, 1 unit of Intermediate Algebra

**College Credit:** Credit is currently available to Coffeyville Community College

**Certification Testing:** Students will be eligible for ASE testing when they have completed the 1,050 hours of training and served one year in a verifiable apprenticeship position.

**Employment Potential:** A variety of businesses employ trained automotive technicians to perform service and repairs. These include dealerships, independent services facilities, specialty centers and fleet facilities.

**Potential Salary Range:** Approximately \$8.00/hr. to start with performance-based increases over time. \$30k-40k/yr is not uncommon after 3-5 years in the business.
